Blue Membership.

To qualify for Blue membership, an applicant must be employed on the editorial staff of a newspaper, periodical, wire service, TV, radio, or other newsgathering organization that reports on the White House. An applicant's job duties must significantly include coverage of the White House. National or Washington-based correspondents and anchors who report regularly but not exclusively on the White House are eligible for Blue membership. Bureau chiefs or senior managers from news organizations that report regularly on the White House but do not participate in pools would be eligible for Blue membership.

What they get:

Blue members get all WHCA emails including pool reports, health advisories and scheduling advisories; and their news outlets are eligible to buy tickets to the annual dinner.

What they pay:

Dues are \$140 a year, which includes a non-refundable credit card fee.
